Setting up of Public Sector Industrial Projects in Konkan (Maharashtra)

1401. PROF. MADHU DANDAVATE: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the backward Konkan region of Maharashtra needs for its development setting up of public sector industrial projects by the Union Government in the interest of correcting the regional imbalances; and
- (b) if so, the details of the concrete plans of the Union Government in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL DEVE-LOPMENT (SHRI M. ARUNACHALAM):
(a) Decisions regarding location of Central Public Enterprises are taken on broad techno-economic considerations. Subject to this, comparatively backward regions are given preference in the location of Central Projects.

(b) As the location of industrial projects is decided on techno-economic feasibilities, it cannot be pre-determined on state-wise basis.

Priority for Ordinary Telepone Connections

1402. Dr. CHINTA MOHAN: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state whether Government propose to give priority to giving ordinary telephone connections before providing Radio Telephone and paying services etc.?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHR1 RAM NIWAS MIRDHA): No Sir, provision of telephone connections is not adversely affected by the mobile radio telephone and radio paging services. These services are provided on a separate radio system and there is a separate waiting list of applicants for the mobile radio telephones and radio paging service.

Introduction of cordless telephones

- (a) whether Government have since introduced the scheme of cordless telephones in vehicles in the country; and
- (b) if so, how much initial amount and monthly rent will be charged by Government;

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI RAM NIWAS MIRDHA): (a) Mobile radio telephone service has been introduced in Delhi for the first time in the country. These telephones are installed in the vehicle of the subscriber.

(b) The demand for a mobile radio telephone can be registered by making an advance deposit of Rs. 1000/-. When the connection is provided, security deposit of Rs. 40,000 for the trans-receiver installed in the car and rental of Rs. 2000 per month is charged.
