THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI A. K. PANJA):
(a) The Films Division is responsible for production of documentary films on various programmes and policies of Government. It is compulsory for all cinema theatres in the country to screen approved documentary films, not exceeding 20 minutes in duration, in every show. As such, a large number of documentary films produced by Films Division which are basically in the nature of information films have been regularly shown by cinema theatres all over the country during the Sixth Plan.

D1 #:

Furthermore, the Directorate of Field Publicity has a network of 257 Field Units spead throughout the country for dissemination of information on programmes and policies of the Government. These Units also acreen documentary films as part of their publicity programmes. As per norms, 80 per cent of such film shows are organised in rural and backward areas.

- , (b) During the Sixth Plan, Films Division had set up two Regional Centres at Calcutta; and Bangalore for production of rural-based featurettes in 16mm in the languages and dialects spoken in the Eastern and Southern regions of the country.
- (c) The National Film Archive of India had set up three Regional Archives during the Sixth Plan located at Bangalore, Calcutta and Trivandrum.
- (d) No threaters are constructed/used exclusively for the exhibition of Films Division films and Children's films.

Release of HYV of soyabean

5645. SHRI P. R. S. VENKATESAN: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state the details of new high Yielding Varieties of soyabean which are resistant to pests, released during the last one years?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COOPERATION IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): A Soybean variety, PK-472 has been released and notified in 1986 for commercial cultivation in the Central Zone comprising of the States of Madbya Pradesh Maharashtra and Gujarat. This variety is resistant/highly tolerant to yellow mosaic, bacterial pustules and leaf spot diseases. It is less susceptible to girdle beetle as compared to popular variety Gaurav.
