## Gas-based Fertiliser Production

5669. DR. P. VALLAL PERUMAN: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government have any proposal to introduce gas-based fertiliser production in various parts of the country in view of the successful commissioning of giant gas-based fertiliser plant in Hazira, Gujarat;
- (b) whether Government are also considering the supply of gas to other industrial units including the power sector in other regions; and
- (c) if so, whether Government would be able to meet the demand of gas both for industrial and domestic purposes?
