Promotion Council has not criticised the enactment of the law regarding the banning of the child labour in the country, they have represented against its applicability to the handknotted carpet industry.

(b) Since there is no evidence to prove that carpet weaving is not injurious to the health of the child workers, the employment was not excluded from the Schedule of banned employment to the Child Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Act, 1986.

(c) Yes, Sir. However, the project at Varanasi is yet to start.

(d) Levy of a cess for creation of a welfare fund for child labour has not been found feasible.

Work done by Federation of Fisherics Associations
