(e) The Government have taken a series of measures for boosting the export of engineering goods. These include, interalia, continuation and strengthening of International Price Reimbursement Scheme, ciberalisation of imports for export production, link deals for exports and lines of credits to some countries.

Seizure of Heroin in Rajasthan

- (a) whether attention of Government has been drawn to the news item appearing in the 'Hindustan Times' on 20th July, 1985 wherein it has been stated that heroin worth Rs. 16 crores had been seized in Rajasthan which is the biggest narcotic catch in the country's history;
 - (b) if so, the details of facts; and
- (c) whether any action has been taken in regard thereto?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI JANARDHANA POOJARY): (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) During an encounter on 17th July, 1985, between an armed gang of smugglers and BSF patrol party ex-BOP Panchala of Barmer Sector, the BSF seized 325.740 Kgs, of substance said to be heroin, the value of which according to BSF is Rs. 16.29 crores. No arrest was made. Six camels used by smugglers were killed, one injured and another captured alive.
- (e) As the smugglers made good their escape no arrest was made. The contraband was handed over to the Customs authorities and the arms and ammunition to the local police by the BSF, for appropriate action,

Measures to Boost Export of Diamonds:

Exports during 1984-85 remained almost at the same level as in 1983-84. Facility to import essential equipment and tools under OGL, reduction in import duty on a number of essential equipment and tools and sponsoring of delegations to overseas markets are some of the measures taken to boost the export of diamonds.
