engineer to carry out any certification work on the aircraft. The aircraft engineers, by virtue of their licences issued by DGCA carry out the certification work. In case of technical officers no such responsibilities are attached as they do not and are not required to possess any licence/approval for carrying out their duties in engineering department. As such, payment of productivity allowance/ qualification pay to technical officers does not arise.

Free Passes to Freedom Fighters

5206. SHRI HARSH VARDHAN: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of freedom fighters who have been provided with free passes by Government for rail travel indicating the duration thereof;

Freedom Fighters and their widows drawing pension from the Central Revenues are issued Complimentary Card Passes for lifetime, subject to renewal every year. About 44,913 passes have been issued to Freedom fighters upto February, 1990, since reintroduction of the scheme on 31.08.1989.
