Slip System at Railway Stations

1562. **SHRI P.M. SAYEED:**
SHRI KUSUMA
KRISHNA MURTHY:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether a new system has been devised by the Northern Railway to help passengers on important railway stations en-route destination to enable them to locate their coach and then berth numbers after their accommodation is confirmed;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) whether it is proposed to extend the system to other Railways?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI BHAKTA CHARAN DAS):

(a) and (b) A system of issuing slips to passengers, provided with confirmed reservation at road-side stations, indicating the Name of Passenger, Train No., Date of Journey, Class, Coach No., Berth/Seat No., Position of the coach from engine, has been introduced by Northern Railway.

(c) The system has been introduced as an experimental measure and there is no proposal to extend the same on other railways for the present.
