Cement Production

998, SHRI MOHAN SINGH: Will the RIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) the quantity of cement produced in e country during 1991-92 vis-a-vis the omestic requirement:
- (b) whether the government have reeived some new applications for setting up ment factories keeping in view the shortse of cement; and
- (c) if so, the number of new cement ctories likely to be set up in the private ector this year, the location thereof and the ctent to which the shortage of cement would met by the setting up of these factories?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE OF IINISTRY **INDUSTRY** PROF.P.J.KURIEN): (a) Against a projected pmestic demand of 54 million tonnes of ement during 1991-92, the production taret has been fixed at 55 million tonnes. The ctual production of cement during Aprileptember, 1991, was 25.8 million tonnes s compared to 23.2 million tonnes producon during the corresponding period of 1990-1 i.e. a growth of 11%.

(b) There is no shortage of cement in the puntry. Under the new Licensing Policy, ement industry has been delicensed and as uch, the companies do not have to submit pplications to the Government for setting p of new cement factories. However, a total f 28 companies have filed Information lemoranda intimating their intention to sanufacture cement.

(c) A capacity of about 2.2 million tonnes is expected to materialise by way of expansions during the current year.

(b) and (c). The production of fertilizer was suspended in Gorakhpur unit w.e.f. 10th June, 1990.
