#### **Coffee Production**

### 534. SHRI PANDURANG PUNDLIK FUNDKAR: Will the MINISTER OF COM-MERCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the coffee production in the country this year is likely to be less in comparison to last year;
  - (b) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the steps proposed to be taken by the Government to enhance the production of coffee?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE (SHRI SAL-MAN KHURSHEED):(a) and (b). The coffee production in the country during 1992-93 season is likely to be less in comparison to 1991-92 season. Since coffee has a biennial bearing tendency and the crop harvested during previous season was fairly good, a lean crop is expected for 1992-93 season.

- (c) The Coffee Board has taken up several programmes to obtain sustained production and productivity which are as follows:
  - (i) Intensive cultivation programme.
  - (ii) Replanting with new high yielding and disease resistant varieties of coffee.
  - (iii) Extending credit and subsidy facility to the small growers.
  - (iv) Water augmentation programme to utilise available surface and underground water.
  - Effective control of major pests and diseases on coffee by giving special attention.

#### Loans to Farmers by Banks

535. SHRI BIR SINGH MAHATO: SHRI AMARI ROYPRADHAN

Will the MINISTER OF FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the total amount of loans disbursed by public sector banks as on June 30, 1991 during each of the last three years, Satewise:
- (b) the share of lending to small farmers with details of beneficiaries; and
- (c) the steps being taken to increase the ratio of lending to small farmers?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI DALBIR SINGH): (a) and (b). The data reporting system does not generate the information in the manner asked for. However, State-wise amount of advances disbursed by Scheduled Commercial Banks to priority sector as Sell as to small and marginal farmers, alongwith number of beneficiaries, as at the end of June 1988, June, 1989 and June, 1990 (latest available) is given in the attached statement

- (c) A number of steps have been taken with a view to increase the flow of credit to farmers, particularly small and marginal farmers. Banks have been advised to ensure that direct finance extended to agriculture (including allied activities) reaches a level of 18%. Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has also issued detailed guidelines to commercial banks for simplifying and liberalising lending procedures. The important ones are:
  - 1. The interest on crop loans upto Rs. 7,500/- is kept low at 11.5% p.a.

- The interest rate for any investment credit availed of by small and marginal farmers upto Rs. 7,500/is 11.5% p.a. only
- In the case of crop loans availed of by small and marginal farmers the interest debited is not to exceed the principal amount.
- 4. No third party guarantee or collateral security is to be insisted upon

for loans upto Rs. 10,000/-.

- There should be no compounding of interest on current dues in agriculture sector.
- Delegation of appropriate sanctioning powers to the Rural Branch Managers so that majority of loan applications are sanctioned at branch level itself.
