Animal Husbandry

House envisages specific measures for increasing the access of the poor and disadvantaged sections to various housing inputs. However, considering the importance of this sector, Central Government also provides financial assistance to the States as well as Union Territory agencies through financial institutions like National Housing Bank, HUDCO etc., for financing housing activities. Indira Awas Yojana is a centrally sponsored scheme operated by various State Governments in rural areas for the housing of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and freed bonded laborers. Schemes like shelter upgradation of urban poor, night shelters for urban pavement dwellers, low cost sanitation schemes for removal of manual scavenging etc. are also schemes specifically operated by the Central Government with loan and subsidy by State agencies. HUDCO provides 55% of its loans for housing lower income groups in urban and rural areas.

Government of India have also initiated action to ensure largest availability of housing finance and access building materials and technology to all sections of population.
