(b) The pertonne cost of crude oil at the well-head, exclusic of royalty and cess varies from State to State and ranges from Rs. 571.51 per metric tonne to Rs. 12,437 per metric tonne. The weighted average price for curude oil imported during April, 1992 to June, 1992 was \$ 137 per metric tonne.

(b) and (c). DDA has reported that it has not demolished any structure on plots allotted under 20 Point Programme. DDA reports that it has, however got the encroachment removed form its own land failing in Khasra No. 33/1, 9, 10, 11 & 12 min. on 5.2.92. This land was acquired by DDA vide Award No. 157/96-87 dated 19.9.86. Its physical possession was taken over from IAC/L&B Deptt. on 13.10.86.
