Share of Water between Indian and Bangladesh

The issue of river water sharing between India and Bangladesh was discussed during the first meeting of Indo-Bangladesh Joint Committee of Experts (JCE) held at New Delhi in November, 1992. Both sides held in depth discussions to work fo equitable, long-term and comprehensive arrangement for sharing of flows of Ganga, Tista and other major rivers.

Irrigation Potential Hydel capacity of Narmada Sagar

2305. KUMARI PUSHPA DEVI SINGH:Will the Minister of WATER RE-SOURCES be pleased to state:

(a) the irrigation potential hydel capacity of Narmada Sagar Project;

(b) its share for Madhya Pradesh;

(d) Foundation excavation of Main Dam and excavation of Power House has started and work is in progress on Coffer Dam and Diversion Tunnel. Work has also been awarded for Head Race and Tail Race Channels.
