1.	Firozpur	Replacing existing corroded passenger platform shelter on platform No. 1.
2.	Jalandhar City	Improvement to water supply arrangements in station area.
3.	Ludhiana	Replacement of existing steel H. S. tank of 437400 liters capacity.
4.	Jalandhar City	Remodelling of station building in Connection with developing model station (Phase-II).
5.	Amritsar	Extension of shed on platform No.
6.	Ludhiana	Extension of shed on platform No. 2 & 3.
7.	Jalandhar Cantt.	Extension of passenger platform shelter on platform No. 2 & 3.
8.	Bhatinda	Provision of water coolers and water cooler huts on platform at Bhatinda.
9.	<i>Ambala Division</i>	<i>Provision of public address equipment at Rajpura, Sirhind, Sangrur and Abohar station.</i>
10.	Patiala	Improvement to circulating area.
