Production of Sugar in Tamil Nadu

2491. DR (SHRIMATI) K.S. SOUNDA-RAM: Will the Minister of FOOD be pleased to state:

(a) the share of Tamil Nadu in the total production of sugar in the country upto September in the current year;

(b) the percentage of increase registered in sugar production as compared to that of last year; and

(c) the total quantity of sugar produced in Tamil Nadu during the last three years?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF FOOD (SHRI TARUN GOGOI): (a) Out of 132.77 lakh tonnes (provisional) of sugar produced in the country during 1991-92 (October-September) season, the sugar factories in Tamil Nadu produced 12.55 lakh tonnes, which is 9.45% of the total production in the country.

(b) During 1991-92 season, the sugar factories in Tamil Nadu produced 12.55 lakh tonnes (provisional) of sugar as against 11.83 lakh tonnes during the season 1990-91, which shows an increase of 6.09%.
