Power Generation in Bihar

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF POWER (SHRIKALP NATH RAI): (a) Yes, Sir, During the period April -November, 1992, as against a requirement of energy of 5415 million units (MU), the availability was 3335 MUs (including assistance of 1638. 2 MUs from Central Sector and from Northern and North-Eastern regions). Thus the deficit was 2060 MUs i.e. 38.0%

(b) The Main reason for low energy generation in Bihar was poor performance of the thermal power stations in the State, as reflected by PLF of 23.6% during the same period as against the All India average of 54.2%.

(c) Various other measures being taken to increase the availability of power in Bihar include addition of new generating capacity. miximising generation from existing generating stations, implementation of Renevation and Modernisation Programme, Reduction in transmission and Distribution losses, effective load management and energy conservation measures.
