The details of cost of each ongoing mining project costing Rs, 50 crores and above sanctioned by the Government in Coal India Ltd. (CIL) and Singareni Collieries Co.Ltd. (SCCL) alongwith the cost of production likely to be available from, these project during the Eighth Five Year Plan are given in the enclosed statement.

(d) The estimated cost of coat production is worked out on the basis of pre level prevailing at the time to formulation/sanction of proejcts tacking into account targeted protection and sanctioned capital outlay. However, this estimation would very over the years depending on inflation in cost of inputs, increase in wages etc.
