(b) the amount of comesation paid by Indian Air lines in the last three years region-se is given in Amneure II.

- (c) The following steps have been taken to streamline baggage handling;-
- -Indian Ariliens has introduced baggage matching system at base stations
- -Security staff has intensified vigil at the loading/unloading points
- -Registered baggage is being delivered to passengers after matching the baggage counerfils with the bagage tags.
- -All bagage mishanaliny cases are immediately reported to Indian Ariliens Regional Security Department for investigation and remedial measures.
- -The regional baggage cells have been provided with CRT to immediately intiate follow up action in the case of reported mishandling of baggage.
