- (a) whether Health experts have viewed that Hysterectomy is a solution to the problem of managing the mentally retarded:

- (d) if not, the Government's stand on this issue?

## **Foeticide**

- (b) if so, the remedial steps taken/ proposed in this regard;

- (c) whether the Government propose to decriminalise abortion so that the task could be entrusted to trained professionals in order to save the lives being endangered by quacks through clandestine abortions:
  - (d) if so, the details thereof;
  - (e) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (f) the steps proposed by the Government in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI B. SHANKARANAND): (a) to (f). Medical termination of pregnancy is allowed under circumstances specified in and at placed approved under the Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act. 1971. In 1992-93, 6.49 lakh pregnancies were terminated medically (figures provisional). Data is not available on the sex of the foetuses aborted. The Pre-natal Diagnostic Techniques (Regulation and Prevention of Misuse) Bill. 1991 is awaiting consideration in the Lok Sabha. Inter alia. the Bill seeks to prevent the misuse of pre-natal diagnostic techniques for determining the sex of the foetus.
