Promotion of Small Scale Industries

2539. SHRI RAM KAPSE: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government have identified some districts in the country to promote small scale industry and provide financial assistance to those entrepreneurs who are willing to set up industries in these districts; and

(b) if so, the details of the scheme and the number of such districts so identified, State-wise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (DEPARTMENT OF SMALL SCALE INDUSTRIES AND AGRO AND RURAL INDUSTRIES) (SHRI M. ARUNACHALAM): (a) and (b). No, Sir. Government endeavours to promote small industry in all districts of the country. However, RBI have identified 85 districts in the country with major concentration of small units and have decided to extend composite loans there for setting up small units. Banks are the principal lending agencies in respect of 62 districts. While SFC's are principal lending agencies in the remaining 23 districts. Statement showing the 85 districts is enclosed.
