AND AGRO AND RURAL INDUSTRIES) (SHRI M. ARUNACHALAM): (a) to (c). A FICCI delegation consisting of its President and ten other members met the Prime Minister on 12th July, 1994 and presented a document - "Vision 2005-A Strategic Blueprint" for country's development.

So far as Small Scale Industries is concerned FICCI has, interalia, suggested for the urgency to encourage the rapid and efficient growth of Small and Medium Scale Industries by minimising their transaction cost through the provision of targetted infrastructure facilities. In this connection, it may be mentioned that a scheme of Integrated Infrastructural Development (including technological backup services) for small scale industries in rural/backward areas has recently been launched by the Government.

(d) Both Central and State Governments have been providina incentives for the development of Small Scale Industries. Some major incentives are excise exemption/concession. concessional finance, priority sector lending, reservation of items for exclusive production. reservation of items for purchase from small scale machinery on hire purchase, technical consultancy services, testing facilities, common facility services, provision of industrial accommodation etc.
