(a) whether the Government propose to provide separate air tracks for incoming and outgoing flights in the airports in Delhi and other States;

(b) if so, the details thereof, airport-wise;

(c) whether navigational aids were installed after the IAF had agreed to release additional air space for unidirectional corridors;

(d) if so, whether the Government also propose to construct separate corridors for arrival and departure of aeroplanes with a view to reduce the air accidents and facilitates the air traffic to the maximum extent at the Indira Gandhi International Airport;

(e) the estimated cost likely to be incurred on the construction of these corridors; and

(f) the time by which the construction work is likely to be commenced?
