

Title: Regarding shortage of water in Delhi

SHRI PARVESH SAHIB SINGH VERMA (WEST DELHI): Our capital city of Delhi suffers from acute to severe shortages of water from time to time. Delhi's daily water usage in 2021 was estimated to be 1,380 million gallons (5,223 million liters). According to data, about 7.7% of Delhi homes use bottled water, while another 5.04% rely on water tankers to acquire water. Over 380 million gallons of water are lost each day in Delhi due to the demand-supply imbalance.

A Megacity like Delhi which is home to millions of people coming from different walks of life cannot be left suffering without the availability of one of the basic needs which is water. It is the necessity of time that the problem of shortage of water is solved. I urge the Government to take note of this issue.
