

Regarding water shortage in Delhi.-laid

SHRI PARVESH SAHIB SINGH VERMA (WEST DELHI): City of Delhi suffers from acute to severe shortage of water from time to time. Delhi's daily water usage in 2021 was estimated to be 1,380 million gallons (5,223 million litres). According to data, about 7.7% of Delhi homes use bottled water, while another 5.04% rely on water tankers. Over 380 million gallons of water are lost each day in Delhi due to the demand-supply imbalance.

Mega city like Delhi which is home to millions of people coming from different walks of life cannot be left suffering without one of the basic needs i.e., water. It is the necessity of time that the problem of water availability and its shortage in the city is solved. I urge upon the Government to take note of this issue.
