- (a) & (b) The Ministry had launched National Urban Livelihoods Mission (NULM), in 2014-15, to reduce poverty and vulnerability of urban poor households on a sustainable basis in 790 cities. Since February 2016, the scheme has been renamed as Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) and coverage has been extended to all statutory towns. Under DAY-NULM, an amount of ₹5292.30 crore has been allocated since 2014-15 till 30th June, 2023.**
