Regarding establishment of National Rice Research Institute in Jaleswar, Odisha -laid

SHRI PRATAP CHANDRA SARANGI (BALASORE): Rice, being a staple food in many States, holds immense significance for Indians, particularly Odisha. It dominates the agricultural landscape, covering approximately 63% of Odisha, and plays a pivotal role in influencing our State?s economy.
