Need to remove GST on handloom products? laid

SHRIMATI PRATIMA MONDAL (JAYNAGAR): Handloom Sector is one of the largest unorganized sector in India and forms an integrated part of Rural and Semi Rural livelihood. The highly decentralized industry mostly has women in its workforce. The imposition of GST on this sector has led to a creation of an undesirable environment restricting growth. A weaver is attracting GST at every stage of production starting from buying yarn to dying the cloth. This results in an increase in the price of finished products. Due to this, machine made products are preferred due to lower price. Handloom products which were highly in demand have been negatively impacted. This coupled with the blow of pandemic has pushed thousands of weaver into poverty and change of occupation. In order to protect the cultured heritage of handloom production and safeguard the weaver the Government must remove the GST.
