

Need to construct two flyovers at Samserganj and Raghunathganj-I Blocks in Murshidabad district-laid

SHRI KHALILUR RAHAMAN (JANGIPUR): Samserganj and Raghunathganj-I Blocks under Murshidabad district are the most densely populated with population near about 4 lakh respectively. NH-34 is the backbone for transportation of Murshidabad district which intersects both the blocks equally. Dakbanglow Mor and Omarpur junction under Samserganj and Raghunathganj-I Block respectively are the gateway to Jharkhand State, North Bengal and Birbhum district. The presence of Colleges, hospitals, and Railway Crossings and Railway Stations within a range of 1 km leads to jams on a regular basis. Incidents like death in ambulances on the way to hospitals are so frequent in both of the junctions. Construction of a flyover in both of the junctions will be highly beneficial not only for Samserganj and Raghunathganj blocks but also Murshidabad, Malda, Birbhum District, North Bengal and Jharkhand State too. Along with that, it will be very helpful for small-scale businesses growing every day throughout the district which directly impacts the financial sector. Construction of these two flyovers will reduce the travel time between Kolkata and Siliguri by more than two hours. I strongly demand the concerned authority to consider my proposal and take the necessary steps for the construction of these two flyovers at the earliest.
