Improvement of Berahampur-Phulbani Road in Orissa

No final decision has been taken so far about posing a Second Package of State Road schemes to the World Bank for assistance. This scheme, along with other roads proposed by various States, will be projected to the World Bank for consideration after a decision to this effect has been taken.
