- The trade of other species is (iii) regulated strictly according to the conditions of a trade licence under the provisions of Wild Life (Protection) Act. International trade in wild life products of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild fauna and Flora of which India is a member.
- Government of India has cre-(iv) ated Regional offices and subregional offices to monitor and control International trade in wildlife products.
- (v) Financial assistance is provided to state Government to strengthen their anti-poaching infrastructure under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme "Control of poaching and illegal Trade in Wildlife".
- The Wild Life(Protection) Act. (vi) 1972 has been amended. Penalties for poaching and illegal trade have been suitable enhanced.
- Transport of wildlife products (vii) without orders from the authorised officer has been made punishable offence.
