# Repair of Lata Ram Sarup Institute of Tuberculosis and Allied Diseases in Mehrauli

(a) whether the wards in the Lala Ram Sarup Institute of Tuberculosis and Allied Diseases in Mehrauli, Delhi are in a bad shape and need immediate repairs;

(b) whether the CPWD has undertaken to repair them two years back and the funds necessary have already been made available to them for carrying out the repairs;

(c) whether the CPWD have not yet carried out the job entrusted to them;

(d) if so, the reasons for delay in taking up the work; and

(e) the steps proposed to be taken to expedite the repair work and complete it within a time frame?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI M. ARUNACHALAM): (a) to (e). It is correct that Lala Ram Sarup Institute of Tuberculosis and Allied diseases in Mehraull needed repairs. The work of renovation of the Institute was entrusted to the CPWD as a 'deposit work'. As almost all the wards were in need of repairs/renovation and it was not possible to close down the Institute, renovation of all the wards could not be taken up simultaneously. It was, accordingly, decided by the Institute authorities that the renovation may be taken up in one ward at a time. The work in other wards will be taken up only after it is completed in one ward and the same is handed over back to

Institute authorities. It is due to this son that the work has taken more time. Ciose co-ordination is being maintained between the CPWD and the Institute authorities with a view to comple the work in a time frame.
