A working group was set up in the Planning Commission to formulate a long-term strategy for accelerated development of dacoity-prone areas in Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan. working group made a diagnosis of the problem taking note of the development programmes implemented in the dacoityprone areas and felt that the major thrust of any special programme in these areas must hinge on the requirements in regard to ravine raclamation, road development and rural electrification. Keeping this in view. the working group prepared a report for accelerated development in these spheres of activity. Copies of the report have been forwarded to the concerned Ministries for taking follow-up action to formulate centrally sponsored programmes for the dacoity-prone areas.
