THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECH-**NOLOGY AND IN THE DEPARTMENTS** OF OCEAN DEVELOPMENT, ATOMIC ENERGY, SPACE AND ELECTRONICS (SHRI SHIVRAJ V. PATIL) : (a) and (b). Yes, Sir. The draft Seventh Five Year Plan for non-conventional energy sources inter-alia provides for energy plantations of 1.5 million hectares of sub-standard soil or waste land where no agricultural farming is done at present. The programme is proposed to be implemented through State Government, Public Corporations and similar agencies. Suitable sites for the energy plantations will be identified by the State Governments and other competent agencies. The Seventh Plan is not yet finalised.

Resources gap

4336. SHRI A.J.V.B. MAHESWARA RAO :

SHRI V. TULSIRAM :

Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is a fact that resources gap of Rs. 33,000 crores is likely to widen further with additional DA instalment expenditure as a result of the pay commission's report, and likely increase on Defence Expenditure etc.; and

(b) if so, the remedial steps proposed to be taken by Government?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING (SHRI K.R. NARAYANAN): (a) and (b). The draft Seventh Five Year Plan is under finalisation. Therefore, it is premature to say anything definitely about the final resources position of the Seventh Plan. However, the impact of any additional liability arising on account of the Pay Commission's. Report or increase in defence expenditure is not expected to affect the resources to be mobilised for the Plan.

Helicopter service for tourists visiting Kerala

(b) if so, whether there is any proposal to start Helicopter service for tourists ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI ASHOK GEHLOT): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) There is no such proposal at present.
