- (a) whether Government have prepared a master plan for desilting the Chilka lake and make it more attractive to the tourists:
- (b) whether Government will start a bird sanctuary there to make it more attractive; and
  - (c) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI ASHOK GEH-LOT): (a) The Central Department of Tourism has entrusted the Town and Country Planning Organisation to prepare a master plan (land use plan) for the integrated development of Chilka lake at an estimated cost of Rs 8.25 lakhs. However, this plan would not include the desilting of the lake.

(b) and (c). The State Govt. during 1973 have already declared Chilka lake as a protected forest and a sanctuary under the Orissa Forest Shooting Rules 1972.

#### Construction of National Library, Calcutta

4359. SHRI SATYAGOPAL MISRA: Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state :

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government have dropped the idea of construction of 16-Floor building of National Library, Culcutta;

# Curb on employees of Indian Embassies settling down abroad on expiry of tenure

Specific programmes are yet to be worked out. These will be determined based on the usefulness of the activities to the two countries.
