

M/s Standard Pharmaceutical Limited, West Bengal, the Drug Inspector as a matter of abundant caution took two samples of Stanpen tablets Batch Nos. 1460 & 1465 on 29.5.84 available with the Delhi branch office of the manufacturer. Both the samples were reported to be of standard quality by the Government Analyst.

- (v) The Director Drug Control Administration, Government of West Bengal, Calcutta, where the manufacturer is located, was informed by the Drug Control Organisation. The Director, Drug Control Administration, Government of West Bengal, was also informed that 22 boxes of the subject drug were replaced by Delhi branch of the manufacturer to the Health Centre on 4.4.1984.
- (vi) The drug Stanpen Batch No. 1342 was purchased by the World University Service Health Centre vide invoice No. 10070 dated 21.7.1983 and the expiry date shown was November, 1984. On 10.11.1983, no date expired drugs were found in the Medical Store of W.U.S. Health Centre of Delhi University by the Drug Inspector when he inspected the Centre.
- (vii) Regarding reported dispensation of Veganin tablets containing Phenacetin (banned drug) by the Centre, inspection was done on 14.8.1984 and no stock of these tablets was found. The Chief Medical Officer of the Centre also stated that no Veganin tablets were issued to the Dispensary after 18.4.1984. He was also advised not to use any of the fixed dose combination of the banned drugs under Notification No. GSR 578 (E) dated 23.7.1983 by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, New Delhi.
- (viii) On the basis of a News Item dated 20.9.1983 allegations regard-

ing time expired drugs being issued by the Centre were also checked and inspection was carried out on 10.11.1983. No date expired drugs were found in stock at the Medical Store of the Centre.
