The compensation money being paid to the individual acceptors of vasectomy and tubectomy has been raised from Rs. 100/- to Rs. 120/- w.e.f. 9.8.85. The additional amount of Rs. 20/- will be paid to acceptors of sterilisation having three or less children. The additional expenditure will be adjusted in Seventh Plan allocation.

In addition to Telugu Ganga Project, 9 major and 4 medium Irrigation projects sent by Andhra Pradesh are under consideration with Central water Commission, in consultation with the State Government for their techno-economic clearance.
