

**Navodaya Vidyalayas in Uttar Pradesh**

1612. SHRI RAJ KUMAR RAI: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government propose to open Navodaya Vidyalayas in Azamgarh, Maunath Bhajan, and Ballia district in U.P.; and

(b) if so, by what time and if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI L.P. SHAHI): (a) and (b). A Navodaya Vidyalaya in District Azamgarh has already been sanctioned to be started during 1987-88. While a proposal in respect of District Ballia has been received from Government of Uttar Pradesh, no offer is so far received in respect of District Maunath Bhanjan. The Government propose to open Navodaya Vidyalaya in these two districts also by the end of the Seventh Five Year Plan.

(b) and (c). 1. *Supertime Grade* : The post is to be filled by promotion. The recommendations of DPC in this regard have been received and are being processed.

2. *Specialist Grade*: The post has been advertised by the UPSC. Recommendations of the Commission are awaited.

3. *C.M.O. Grade* : The post is expected to be filled up shortly as administrative formalities have almost been completed.

4. *Specialist Gr. II* : In respect of two posts, recommendations of UPSC have been received and these are being processed to complete the administrative formalities.
