the first two years of the Seventh Plan has been below the targets in the following States and UTs.

Andhra Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Madhya Pradesh, Orissa, Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal and some North Eastern States (Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland and Tripura) and farflung UTs of A & N Islands, Pondicherry and Lakshadweep.

(d) The Ministries implementing the programmes have initiated various steps for achieving the target. The programmes have been taken up more effectively during 1987-88.

## Production of Documentary Films in Regional Languages

- 1732. PROF NARAIN CHAND PAR-ASHAR: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:
- (a) whether any steps have been taken to support the production of documentary films in regional languages and dialects by the Film Corporation of India;
- (b) if so, the names of projects in which financial and technical assistance has been provided during the Seventh Plan and the programme for the remaining two years; and

THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI H.K.L. BHAGAT): (a) Films Division of the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting produces documentaries in English and Hindi as basic various, and, after dubbing these are released in cinema theatres all over the country in all the 14 Regional Lan-

guages.

During the Sixth Five Year Plan, Films Division set up two Regional Production Centres at Calcutta and Bangalore for production of 16mm feature films in regional Languages and dialects of the respective region as for rural audiences.

National Film Development Corporation also finances production of documentary films in English, Hindi and Regional Languages and dialects sponsored by different Ministries and Departments as and when requests are received for such financial assistance.

(b) and (c). In the case of Films Division during the Seventh Plan so far, 15 featurettes have been produced and dubbed and 6 more are expected to be completed by March,88. For the remaining two years of Seventh Plan, namely 1988-89 and 1989-90, it is proposed to undertake production of 32 featurettes in regional languages and dialects of Eastern and Southern Regions by the two Regional Centres.

National Film Development Corporation has not received any application for financing or producing documentary films in regional languages and dialects. If any application is received during the remaining two years of the Seventh Plan period, the same will be considered and loans sanctioned subject to the merits of the projects and their fulfilling necessary requirements.
