THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMENT-ARY AFFAIRS AND MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCAST-ING (SHRI H.K.L. BHAGAT): (a) to (d) While no formal procedure for associating Theatre and Ballet Groups has been laid down, various Doordarshan Kendras invite such groups to present their productions. The broad guideline is relevance and importance of the theme of the programme and exigencies of programme requirement. The remuneration payable to each group varies depending on the number of participants and the costumes, sets and special effects used in the production. In case of plays such remuneration ranges from Rs. 5000/- to Rs. 10,000/- for short plays and Rs. 15,000/- to Rs. 30,000/- for long plays. No cataloguing and detailed indexing regarding booking of such groups by various Doordarshan Kendras is maintained centrally.

Shortage of Bus/Truck tyres

shortages in the market of certain categories of truck & bus tyres. According to the Automotive Tyre Manufacturers Association, these temporary shortages were due to labour problem leading to closure or slow down of production of a number of tyre units.

Government are in regular touch with the tyre manufacturers in order to maximise production of tyres and tubes. Government have also decided to allow the import of specified categories of bus and truck tyres on OGL by State Transport Undertakings or their Association and recognised State Level Associations of Road Transport Operators.
