

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE AND MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI MOTILAL VORA) :

(a) Yes, Sir.

(b) and (c). Apart from the aircraft proposed to be transferred from Indian Airlines, Vayudoot may acquire some 40 plus seater turbo-prop aircraft. The additional aircraft capacity will be utilised to consolidate operations on the existing routes and to connect such new stations as are found feasible to operate and have the required ground in infrastructure.

**Navodaya Vidyalaya at Tiruvuru (A.P.)**

10809. SHRI V. SOBHANADREESWARA RAO: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government of Andhra Pradesh has recommended for opening a Navodaya Vidyalaya at Tiruvuru a backward area of Krishna district in Andhra Pradesh; and

(b) if so, the time by which the Vidyalaya is likely to be started at Tiruvuru?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI L.P.SHAH) :(a) and (b). Yes, Sir. The location and sanction of the Vidyalaya in Krishna district is yet to be decided.

**Four Laning of National Highway No. 5 In Orissa**

(a) whether four laning of National Highway No. 5 from O.M.P. Junction to Mahanadi

(b) if so, the details thereof including the total estimated cost of the proposal; and

(c) the time schedule for its completion?

(b) The physical progress made so far is 77%. The total estimated cost of the proposal is Rs. 91.42 lakhs.

(c) The work is targetted for completion in December, 1988.

(d) whether international flights from Ahmedabad will ease pressure on Bombay and would result in great charter potentiality; and

(e) when the decision on the proposal is likely to be taken?
