## Coal Deposits in Nagpur Districts of Maharashtra

Exploratory drilling has been taken up in new blocks of Nagpur district. The drilling work undertaken in the district has increased from 10400 metres in 1987-88 to 17000 metres in 1988-89. A total of 24000 metres has been programmed for drilling in 1989-90.
