Salal Project (Phase-II)

6818. SHRI MOHD. AYUB KHAN (Udhampur): Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether work on phase-II of the Salal project (Jammu and Kashmir) has started;

(b) if not, the steps taken so far or proposed to start the work early;

(c) the amount sanctioned for the work ; and

(d) the agency selected to carry out the task?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF POWER IN THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY (SHRI KALPNATH RAI): (a) to (d). The work on Salal HE Project, Stage-II would be started in full swing only after the investment decision is taken by the Government. The project has already been cleared by Public Investment Board recently. The project is estimated to cost Rs. 279.97 crores excluding interest during construction of Rs. 23.81 crores. The project is proposed to be executed in the Central Sector through National Hydro-electric Power Corporation. Pending the investment decision, the Corporation have taken up certain preliminary works of the project.

World Bank Assistance for Rural Electrification Programme

6819. SHRI MANIK REDDY: Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to state:

(a) the financial assistance provided by the World Bank for rural electrification programme during 1988-89; and

(b) the details of the allocations made to Andhra Pradesh from the World Bank assistance since 1988?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF POWER IN THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY (SHRI KALPNATH RAI):

(a) During 1988-89, World Bank provided \$ 23.731 million to Government of India for Rural Electrification Programme.

(b) Andhra Pradesh State Electricity Board procured materials under this credit for their Rural Electrification works. During 1988-89, Andhra Pradesh Electricity Board procured \$ 10.526 million worth of materials under World Bank credit.
