observations on the shape of things and are, therefore, relevant only in the longer run perspective. Some others are in the nature of rationalisation and development of the financial system and have, therefore, to be implemented in phased manner. While a large number of recommendations have already been acted upon, some are necessarily being implemented in stages, since they depend upon growth of monetary and financial system.

In view of the above, it is not possible to indicate a definite time-frame for completing the implementation of all the recommendations of the Committee.

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MADHAVARAO SCINDIA): The target of track renewal for 1989-90 has been fixed as 3550 Km.

Opening of Office of Regional Manager of State Bank of India at Gangtok

(a) whether all the North-Eastern States viz. Meghalaya, Nagaland, Tripura, Mizoram, Assam and Arunachal Pradesh are having offices of the Regional Managers of the State Bank of India in their capitals;

(d) if not, the reasons therefor?

Regional Offices/Zonal Offices, which are controlling offices of banks, are set up by the banks keeping in view the number of branches to be controlled, their level of business, geographical contiguity, availability of infrastructural facilities, administrative conveniences, cost-benefit analysis etc.
