**Bio-Gas Plants**

2178. SHRI JAGANNATH PATTNAIK:  
Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to state:

(a) what is the number of bio-gas plants at present functioning in the country, State-wise;

(b) what is the number of such plants which were set up in different State during the Seventh Five Year Plan; and

(c) what is the number of such bio-gas plants which are still to be set up during the Seventh Five Year Plan, State-wise?

THE MINISTER OF ENERGY (SHRI VASANT SATHE): (a) and (b). Under the National Project for Biogas Development, which caters to family type biogas plants, a total of over 10.75 lakh biogas plants have

been set up in different States/Union Territories during the period 1981-82 to 1988-89, out of which over 7.3 lakhs plants have been set up during the first four years of the Seventh Plan Period. State-wise are given in statement-I below. The responsibility for proper operation and maintenance of biogas plants lies with individual owners and accordingly the functioning of plant varies. Reports of evaluation survey studies completed recently by independent agencies in respect of some States (Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Karnataka, Gujarat, West Bengal, Maharashtra and Orissa) indicate that, on an overall basis, over 82.2 percent of plants surveyed have been found functioning.

(c) A target of setting up of 1.6 lakh biogas plants has been fixed for the terminal year of the Seventh Plan period, i.e. 1989-90 for different States/agencies. Details are given in Statement II below.
