Geological Survey of Salem District

(a) whether geological survey of Salem District in Tamil Nadu has revealed existence of minerals other than iron; and

(b) if so, the nature of minerals found the estimated reserves and the arrangements proposed for detailed prospecting ?

THE MINISTER OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRI BIJU PATNAIK) : (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The minerals found as a result of these surveys and their approximate reserves in million tonnes are as follows :

(a) Magnesite (43.0)

(b) Bauxite (8.0)

(c) Limestone (50.0)

(d) Chromite (0.2)

(e) Quartz (3.0)

(f) Felspar (1.0)

(g) Steatite (0.06)

Detailed survey of Bauxite has been completed. Investigations for Chromite and Magnesite are being taken up.
