Jagatdal for the benefit of Jute Workers in Barrackpore Sub-division, West Bengal; and

(b) if  $s_2$ , the facts thereof; and if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMEN TARY AFFAIRS AND LABOUR (SHRI RAVINDRA VARMA): (a) and (b). The Employees' State Insurance Corporation have reported that there is a proposal to set up a hospital at Jagatdal or any other suitable place in North 24-Parganas. The selection of land and other details are awaited from the Government of West Bengal.

## Kolihan Copper Mine Development

5212. SHRIS.G. MURUGAIYAN: Will the Minister of STEEL AND MINES be pleased to state:

(a) whether the development, per month of Kolihan copper mine is much less than the target fixed;

(b) if so, the reasons thereof; and

(c) when the decline at Kol ihan copper mine will reach at 304 ML?

THE MINISTER OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRI BIJU PATNAIK): (a) No, Sir.

(b) Does not arise.

(c) The decline at Kolihan copper mine has already reached 306 ML in April, 1977.

## C.G.H.S. Dispensary in Trans-Yamuna Area

5213. SHRIS. G. MURUGAIYAN: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware that a large number of Govrenment employees stay in Laxmi Nagar and Shakarpur (Trans-Yamuna) area;

(b) whether there is no C.G.H.S. dispensary in these areas; and

(c) if so, the steps taken in the matter ?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI RAJ NARAIN): (a) Yes, Sir. As per the information with the Government, there are about five-thousand Government employees residing in these areas. (b) and (c). There are two dispensaries—one at Shahdara and the other at Gandhi Nager—covering most of the Trans-Yamuna area. A proposal for setting up the third dispensary in the uncovered area is under consideration.

## Conversion of Institute of Opthalmology of Aligarh Muslim Univerlaity into a regional Institute

5215. SHRI RASHEED MASOOD: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the expert Committee which was sent to determine the feasibility of the proposal of converting the Institute of Ophthalmology of the Aligarh Muslim University into a Regional Institute had recommended favourably on the proposal and suggested that the Gandhi Eye Hospital, Aligarh be attached to the proposed Regional Institute; and

(b) if so, the action taken on the recommendations?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI RAJ NARAIN): (a) and (b). No expert Committee was sent by the Centre to determine the feasibility of the proposal of converting the Institute of Ophthalmology of the Aligarh Muslim University into a Regional Institute. However, under the National Plan for Prevention of Visual Impairment and Control of Blindness, it is envisaged that the existing six Institutes of Ophthalmology in the country including that at Aligarh could be developed into a Regional Institute.

## Building of Depoli Post Office Building

5216. SHRI BAPUSAHEB PARU-LEKAR: Will the Minister of COM-MUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Post Office at Depoli is housed in a departmental building which is 110 years old and is in a dilapidated condition and that the accommodation available in this building is too short of the minimum requirement considering the present strength of Office;

(b) whether a proposal of expansion and renovation of the building was taken up in the year 1971-72 and plans and estimates also were prepared and permission of Revenue Authorities were obtained for this purpose; and
