- (b) Whether there is a demand from different hospitals or medical organisations to increase this amount;
- (c) how much do they expect per day per patient; and
 - (d) the decision taken in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF PARLIA-MENTARY AFFAIRS AND LABOUR (SHRI RAVINDRA VERMA): The Employees' State Insurance Corparation have furnished the following information:

- (a) Yes. The hospitals in Bombay are being paid reservation charges at the rate of Rs. 12/- per day per patient in respect of the beds reserved for the E.S.I. beneficiaries.
- (b) The Corporation has no information in the matter. They have also not received any proposal from the State Government, who are responsible for administration of medical care under the E.S.I. Scheme, for enhancement of the rates of reservation charges.
 - (c) and (d). Do not arise.

Talks with Representatives of Trade Unions in Steel Industry

5231. DR. BAPU KALDATY: Will the Minister of STEEL AND MINES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the representative of the Trade Unions of workers in steel industry were invited to Delhi for talks on 5th July, 1977;
 - (b) if so, what was the agenda; and
 - (c) who were invited for the discussion?

THE MINISTER OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRI BIJU PATNAIK):
(a) to (c). Six Working Groups have been constituted to study various aspects of the working of the steel industry as indicated below and to make available to Government their recommendations/suggestions for its improved functioning:—

- (i) Production and Productivity.
- (ii) Workers participation at all levels.
- (iii) Welfare and social objectives.
- (iv) Marketing, pricing and finance.
- (v) Modalities of having one Union for each plant, and one Union for the steel industry at the national level.

(vi) Perspective of expansion of steel plant; and setting up of new steel plants on the basis of funds obtained from outside.

The Groups consist of representatives of Steel Plants Managements and of Trade Unions (Central Trade Unions, namely, INTUC, AITUC, CITU, HMS. B.M.S. UTUC, UTUC, (Lenin Sarani) and NFITU and recognised and registered trade unions at the steel plants.

The Groups had met earlier in April and May, 1977. They again met at Delhi from 5th to 7th July, 1977 to continue their deliberations.
