(b) As a result of investigations carried out by Geological Survey of India, about 224 milion tonnes of limestone of eement and flux grade ; 165 million tonnes of coal; 35 million tonnes of Lithomerge clays and 5,000 tonnes of fireclay were estimated in different parts of the State ;
(c) Feasibility studies for exploitation of limestone and coal are being carried out by the concerned agencies.
