cent of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes students, respectively. There is no separate reservation for handicapped students. The number of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes students admitted in Kendriya Vidyalayas in Delhi for the last three years is as under:—

The information regarding number of handicapped students admitted is not available.

- (b) The medium of instruction for humanities and social science subjects is Hindi and for mathematics and science subjects is English.
- (c) The languages taught are Hindi, English and Sanskrit.
- (d) Two languages, namely Hindi and English are being taught as compulsory languages in classes IX and X. Sanskrit is being taught as an additional compulsory subject upto class IX. Students may, however, continue to study Sanskrit in Class X also for which facilities have been provided in Vidyalayas.
