**Voluntary Agencies for Spreading Non-Formal and Adult Education**

1111. SHRI K. RAMAMURTHY: Will the Minister of EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) the names of 50 voluntary agencies financially assisted by the Education Ministry in 1976-77 for spreading non-formal and adult education;

(b) the quantum of assistance given to each agency; and

(c) what checks were kept to see how that money has been utilised by those agencies?

(c) Every voluntary agency is required to furnish a progress report and audited statement of accounts. In some cases, on the spot inspections are also conducted. A copy of the sanction is endorsed to the State Governments which are expected to oversee the manner in which funds are utilised.

(b) what plans are being made for the minor lift irrigation small dams and tanks on the three main rivers Parbati, Kali Sindi and Nevach in the above districts?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND IRRIGATION (SHRI BHANI PRATAP SINGH): (a) and (b). The Government of Madhya Pradesh have submitted project reports in respect of Halali, Sagar and Bah Projects to benefit areas in Vidisha district, Dudhi Project to benefit areas in Rajgarh district and Parbati Project to benefit areas in Rajgarh, Guna, Sehore and Bhopal districts of the State, to the Central Water Commission. One medium scheme namely, Shamsherpura Tank Project, to benefit areas in Rajgarh district was approved by the Planning Commission in September, 1977.

Information in respect of minor irrigation works is being collected from the State Government and will be laid on the Table of the House as soon as it is received.

**Financial Crisis in Khandasari Manufacturing Units**
