THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI S. KUNDU): Yes, Sir.

**Patients in Willingdon Hospital, New Delhi**

4768. SHRI PADMACHARAN SAMANTASINHERA: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware that the Willingdon Hospital, New Delhi is

running with inadequate staff in proportion to the number of patients treated there;

(b) if so, the daily average of the indoor and outdoor patients treated there in the last three years and till date;

(c) the number of doctors and staff working there; and

(d) when and how many extra doctors and staff are being posted there?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE: (SHRI JAGDAMBI PRASAD YADAV) (a) Keeping in view the given resources the staff posted in the Willingdon Hospital, New Delhi is not considered inadequate.

(b) The daily average attendance of patients in the OPD and admissions in the Indoor is as under:—

(c) The Willingdon Hospital has on its strength 204 doctors and 1247 other categories of staff.

(d) To strengthen the Accident and Emergency Department, posts of 11 doctors, 2 Nurses and 2 Stretcher Bearers have recently been sanctioned.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI NARHARI PRASAD SUKHDEO SAI): (a) Total number of Post Offices proposed to be opened 69.

(c) and (d) In most of the proposals for opening of post offices in Phulbani District, anticipated loss was found to be beyond the permissible limit of loss. The target for opening new Post Offices in this district is the second highest among backward districts of Orissa. Efforts are being made to fulfil the target of opening 20 post offices as proposed for the year 1977-78.

#### राज्यों द्वारा खनिजों के निर्यात पर रायल्टी में वृद्धि की मांग

4770. डा० लक्ष्मीनारायण पांडेय : क्या इस्पात और खान मंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि :

(क) क्या विभिन्न राज्यों द्वारा उन राज्यों से निर्यात किये जाने वाले खनिजों पर केन्द्रीय सरकार द्वारा दी जाने वाली रायल्टी में वृद्धि किये जाने की मांग की गई है;

(ख) खनिजों पर रायल्टी का निर्धारण कब किया गया था; और

(ग) इस बारे में सरकार ने क्या कार्यवाही की है अथवा इस बारे में सरकार की क्या प्रतिक्रिया है?

इस्पात और खान मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (श्री करिषा मुष्ठा): (क) कुछ राज्यों ने अनुरोध किया है कि लौह अयस्क, तांबा अयस्क, मैंगनीज अयस्क और मैंगनेजाइट जैसे कुछ खनिजों पर रायल्टी बढ़ा दी जाये।

(ख) कोयला समेत अनेक खनिजों पर केवल कुछ खनिजों को छोड़कर रायल्टी दरों में पिछली बार वृद्धि मार्च, 1975 में की गई थी।
